PORTERS PARK

Porters Park is a golfing gem located in rural Hertfordshire. It is a parkland course featuring a wonderfully varied selection of pine and deciduous trees. Each hole is memorable in character.

The course originated from the park, known as Porters dating back to 1340, which John Le Porter owned. The famous architect Nicholas Hawksmoor lived at Porters in 1728, John Mason in 1748 and Lord Howe, a great name in naval history in 1772. It was in the late nineteenth century when the attractive park was described as '*designed by providence to be a golf course*'. All that was needed was a man of enthusiasm, vision and energy to suggest that Porters be defined as a golf course. In the 1890's that man arrived - his name was Dr. Ross Smyth. And so Porters Park was born, being ready to play in 1899.

The only other remaining evidence of the Porters estate is the old Mansion House, perched on the hill to the east of the course at Shenley. Also one of the original ice houses is located in the pine copse on the right of the 3rd fairway.

The Clubhouse was extended in 1991, but retains the older features of the domed ballroom/lounge and gabled 1st floor offices over the members bar. The dining room affords a wonderful view of the opening hole, while the ballroom/lounge view the opening and closing holes, and no doubt will provide the visiting golfers with a memory to treasure of this truly magnificent course.

SOCIETY DAYS AT PORTERS PARK

Societies are extremely welcome at Porters Park. Over the years the Club has developed a format for visiting societies that guarantees a pleasant, sociable day and a great golfing experience. As with all Golf Clubs we do have rules, but they are designed to ensure that your timetable for the day is met, that you enjoy uninterrupted play and that your society integrates smoothly into the culture and activities of Porters Park.

Format for the Day

Societies with a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 40 playing members can be accommodated. Either 18, 27 or 36 holes may be played with a choice of refreshments before, between and after play (see Tariff sheet).

To meet your timetable for the day and to speed up play, we ask you to play Stableford (rather than Medal or Texas Scramble) as a 3 ball or Greensome Foursomes, both in the morning and afternoon.

Please play from the Yellow Tees.

These times are reserved for your exclusive use. Unfortunately, we are unable to make any adjustments or extensions on the day.

Meals and Refreshments

We offer a choice of menus, which are available on request, including vegetarian dishes and a full English breakfast if required. We ask you to confirm all your selections when advising us of your final numbers.

Use of Clubhouse and Facilities

You will have free access to all the Club's facilities including the Member's Locker Room and showers (towels are provided), spike bar, lounge, Palm Court and patio.

Dress Code

Porters Park is a traditional Golf Club and we ask visitors to dress appropriately whilst playing and socialising. On the course this means wearing proper golf shoes and golf trousers or shorts (with white socks please). In the clubhouse we would ask you not to wear trainers or denim jeans and to wear a jacket and tie for dinner. Obviously these rules can be relaxed in hot weather and jackets may also be removed when you sit down to dine if you prefer.

Please advise your members of our dress code. We do reserve the right to ask your visitors to leave the course or the clubhouse if they fail to comply but it is obviously embarrassing for us to do so.

Mobile Phones

Calls may be made in the car park but not in the clubhouse and patio area or on the course.

Standard of Play

All players are expected to have a Club or Society handicap. Our course is not suitable for absolute beginners and it will spoil your enjoyment and theirs. Also it is important that players know and observe the etiquette of golf.

Care of the Course

Could you please ask your members to:

- Repair pitch marks
- Replace divots
- Rake bunkers (and leave rakes in them)
- Play briskly (3 ¾ hours for a 3 ball).

Car Park Security

On entering and leaving the car park there are clear instructions on how the security system works. Basically you have to wait for the green light to show.

To leave the car park you will need to obtain a code number from the Managing Secretary, the Professional or a member of the bar staff.

Personal Belongings

Thefts from Golf Clubs are all too common and we ask you to avoid leaving any valuables lying around in the locker room and that, if possible, you store your clubs in your car when you are not playing.

Booking Procedure

Please post the enclosed booking form as early as possible with your deposit. Upon receipt, a confirmation of booking will be sent to you.

Reservation Fee

Please send a non-refundable fee of £10 per head to secure your booking. A minimum of 20 players is required for Bronze and Silver packages, and 24 players for Gold and Platinum.

Confirmation of Numbers

Confirmation of your attendance numbers must be made seven (7) days before the event. The Club reserve the right to charge 100% of the cost for the number confirmed if a lower number attend.

Cancellation charges

Should you have to cancel your visit the following charges will apply:-

* The cost of the day is calculated by multiplying the number of people stated on the booking confirmation form by the cost per person.

Settlement of Account

A bill of the final amount outstanding will be presented to your Secretary/Organiser on the day and payment in full must be made to the Club Office or Managing Secretary before you depart.

Payment Terms

Payment must be on the day or if previously agreed within 7 days of invoice date. Any queries must be notified immediately on receipt of invoice. Payment may be made by cash, cheque or card (please note, there is a small fee for credit card payments).

DIRECTIONS TO PORTERS PARK GOLF CLUB

M25 - IF COMING FROM THE DARTFORD TUNNEL

Exit at Junction 22, go straight across the roundabout taking the directions to Radlett. Go straight across the next roundabout along a country road to next roundabout, turn left. Sign to Shenley. Follow road to mini-roundabout. Go straight across and up the hill. At the top of the hill turn right at roundabout and then first left into Radlett Lane. Follow the road and you will see signs of the golf course on your right and further along you will see the entrance on a bend.

M25 - IF COMING FROM HEATHROW

Exit at Junction 22. Take the 5th turning off roundabout marked Radlett. You will then come to a roundabout, turn right taking directions to Radlett. Go straight across the next roundabout along a country road to next roundabout, turn left. Sign to Shenley. Follow road to mini-roundabout. Go straight across and up the hill. At the top of the hill turn right at roundabout and then first left into Radlett Lane. Follow the road and you will see signs of the golf course on your right and further along you will see the entrance on a bend.

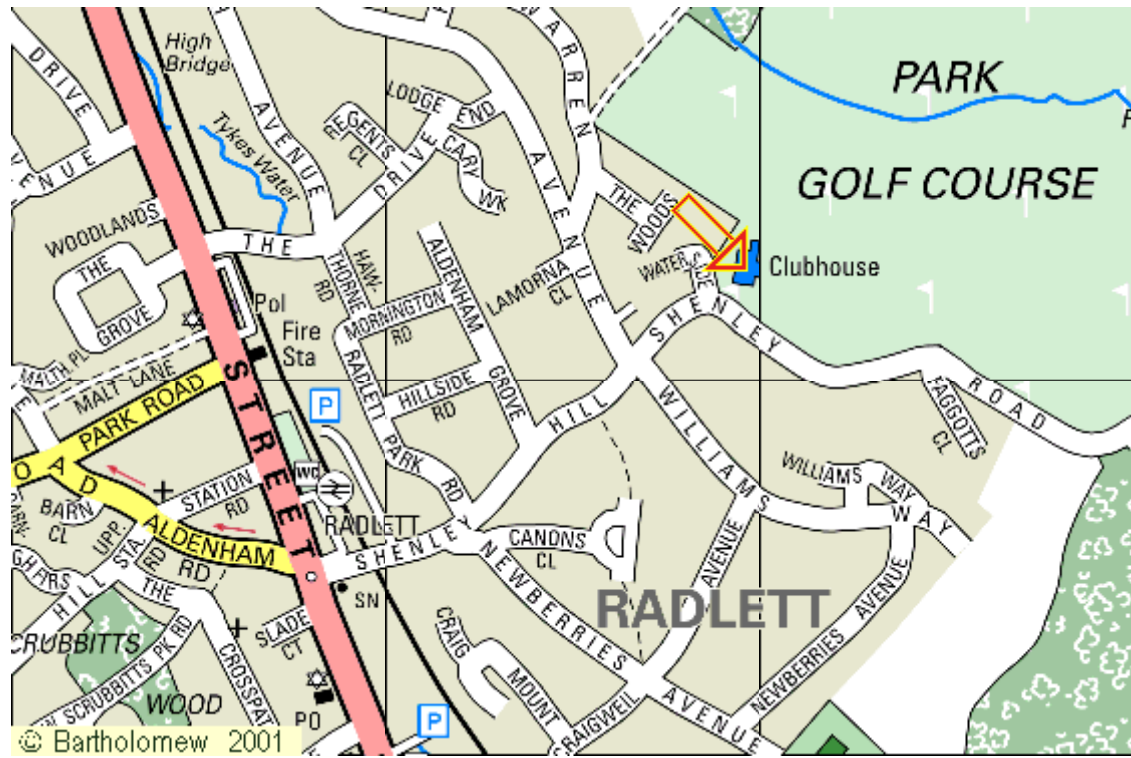
M1 - FROM THE NORTH

Exit at Junction 7 onto the A414 (Hatfield). After about 2 miles at roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A5183 and continue on this road to Radlett. Go straight across first mini-roundabout and left at the next mini-roundabout into Shenley Hill. Continue up the hill, across a mini-roundabout, and the entrance is to the Club is on the left on a bend.

M1 - FROM THE SOUTH

Exit M1 at Junction 5. Take the first exit onto the A41. At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto B462 signposted to Radlett. Follow this road, over two mini-roundabouts into Radlett. At the T- junction mini-roundabout turn right. At the next mini-roundabout turn left into Shenley Hill.

Continue up the hill, across a mini-roundabout, and the entrance is to the Club is on the left on a bend.
